

# Insulin Cost Cap Program

- Many Americans with diabetes struggle with the high cost of their insulin medication.

## Problem:

Over 30 million Americans have diabetes, and more than 7 million of them require daily insulin. The average retail price per insulin unit rose 54% from 2014 to 2019. More than 1 million adults in the United States are rationing insulin due to the drug's high costs.

\*A survey conducted on U.S. adult insulin users provided insight on how insulin users try to save money in dealing with the high cost of insulin. The survey results were the following:

- Any method of rationing: 17%
- Delayed buying insulin: 14%
- Took less insulin: 11%
- Skipped doses of insulin: 10%
